

What to bring with you to your advisement session?

- Your DARS report (Print your own in the FCS Dept. Office from 8:00am-5:00pm). Circle or highlight the requirements you have left.
- Paper and Pen/Pencil (Take notes!)
- CSU Northridge Catalog
- Your Academic File, available from Dept. Office.
- Transcript or grade slips from other colleges you have attended; these do not need to be official.

When selecting your course schedule remember to:

- Plan for your General Education courses.
- Make sure you have taken the prerequisites for the courses you plan to take.
- Write out a two year plan of courses you need to take.
- Consider that many FCS courses are offered only once a year and plan accordingly.
- If you are taking restricted classes (e.g., FCS 494) for the upcoming semester, plan to get a permission number by emailing the faculty teaching the course.
- Part time faculty will be unable to give you a permission number until six weeks prior to the semester starting. In this case you should email the faculty member within the advisement period and request a permission number, but remember you may have to wait for a response.
